#### JUNIOR SECTION 4-8 YRS, 9-12 YRS

Class 1254 GRASS HEAD  
Method - Sprinkle some grass seeds into the bottom of the stocking foot and fill it with potting mix or sphagnum moss. Twist the stocking until it is the shape and size of tennis ball, and then tie it off leaving about 10cm dangling down at the bottom.  
Use an elastic band to make a bulging nose in the stocking face.  
Give your grass head a goofy face, glue on googly eyes, pipe cleaners for eyebrows and any decorations you like. Half fill a small container (eg Yoghurt container) with water and place the head on top, so the stocking tail is dangling into the water. Use a spray bottle of water to moisten his head.  
Place him on a window sill that gets plenty of sun. Check each day to make sure the stocking head remains damp.
